

REPORT FROM THE PRESIDENT

Following a cocktail hour and a spectacular dinner, we enjoyed a talk by George J. Hill, M.D., speaking on 'Reconciliation'. Aztec Club members and their wives enjoyed a spring outing on May 11 by visiting Beauvoir, the restored home and new Presidential Library of Jefferson Davis, led by our host, his GG Grandson, Bertram Hayes-Davis. Five of the seven buildings on the site were destroyed and the remaining two, including the main house, were heavily damaged when Hurricane Katrina tore through Biloxi, Mississippi on August 29, 2005. Mr.

Hayes-Davis, a member of the Aztec Club since 1978, leads the *Friends of Beau-voir* in the restoration and preservation of the antebellum home and associated art, furnishings, textiles, and militaria. He, his wife and *Friends* have done a splendid job of recapturing the look and feel of the house as it was during Davis' lifetime.

Jefferson Davis, while remembered as President of the Confederate States of America, also served as United States Secretary of War, United States Senator, and a Colonel of the First Mississippi Rifle Volunteers in the Mexican War. He figured prominently in the victory at Buena Vista against overwhelming odds, and although he was severely wounded in the battle, remained in the saddle until the close of the action.



Following a film presentation on the life of Jefferson Davis and lunch in the boardroom of the modern, expansive Library, our host presented a talk and discussion of the period from the Mexican War to the Civil War. We extend our thanks to Bertram and Carol for a most educational and enjoyable day. In attandance were Max and Margaret Maxwell, Carlo and Rosemonde Capomazza, Ed and Cindy Bush, Howard and Sara Gaines, Peter and Dianne Labouisse.


Congratulations to Carlo Capomazza for success in recruiting. He informs me that we now have 20 members in the New Orleans area.


